It was a gathering of the Chapter leaders from Russia representing about 35 Chapters. One of the young men 25 years of age flew 10 hours across Russia to come to the meeting. It only took me 12 hours to fly from Los Angeles. He has his own company with 40 employees and is separated only by a river from the country of China. I asked him what religion the Chinese are. His unique response, "They don't have any religion." What a tremendous market for souls! Others flew eight hours to come to the meeting. The average Chapter president is around 40 years of age, very spiritual and extremely hungry for the things of God. All are very successful in their business.

One of the surprising elements was to see the economic boom in the nation as compared to eight years ago. Moscow is now considered one of the most expensive cities in the World. It is perhaps one of the best foundations of men I've seen to build the Fellowship to thousand of Chapters. Our leader from Nicaragua, Humberto Arguello, was there with a team. They were teaching the Russian men how to fish for souls in the marketplace. One of their emphasis is to keep it as a businessmen's organization and get away from having church-type meetings. The Chapters are focused on businessmen testimonies. They are having the meetings setup in a business atmosphere to attract businessman. If they continue on this trend, success is inevitable!

The legacy of FGBMFI has impacted many lives. I still remember being seven years old and going on my first trip away from my parents. I visited Disneyland and a Full Gospel Convention with my grandparents, Ralph (former FGBMFI Executive VP; still preaching strong at 92) and Mae Marinacci. I walked into an auditorium full of people where my grandfather was speaking. It was an anointed message and thousands rushed to the aisle after an alter call. As a young boy I remember thinking the lines were longer than at Disneyland. It was an awesome move of God.

Even though I grew up with a fantastic grandfather and grandmother and a mother who loved the Lord, I went my own way when I graduated from college. I took all the money I had saved and traveled around the world. I came back broke, looking for a job and felt led to settle in Atlanta. There I started working for Direct TV's Dish Network, where I moved up to become the Director of Sales and Operations.

But I soon realized, even though I was doing well in a phenomenal job with great pay, I was totally empty and unfulfilled inside. I began to spend more time with my grandparents and even went to a couple FGBMFI meetings, where I met Jimmy Rogers and heard Richard Shakarian speak. I began to pray for a new direction and career, regardless of where it took me. I re-committed my heart to the Lord and told Him to take over my life.

Not long after, my brother was applying to Regent University, next to the Christian Broadcasting Network (CBN) in Virginia. I took a ride down with him to Virginia Beach, and while there made an unplanned stop at CBN's Human Resources

wearing jeans and a sweatshirt. I said, "I'm not really sure what you do, but if you're interested, I'll make myself available." Through a series of divinely-orchestrated steps, I was hired in a managerial position at CBN, working in live television. The only problem was I had never worked directly in television before! In my first meeting with Pat Robertson he turned to me and said, "I don't know why they hired you. You know nothing about what we do." I said, "Before you go any further, can I ask you a question? Do you remember a charismatic Italian named Ralph Marinacci who used to come down here and kick rats out of your first TV studio with some other Full Gospel Businessmen? He's my grandfather." He said, "Ralph Marinacci and the Full Gospel Businessmen? That's it! You can stay!" In fact, to this day, Pat Robertson still talks about his involvement with the Full Gospel Businessmen as some of the best days of his life.

I had favor at CBN. I had a rewarding job, a good salary, and lots of responsibility. I got married and started a family. But God started to stir a vision in my heart. It began with my grandmother Mae. She ended up in a nursing home, recovering from surgery. She was pressing her buzzer one day for someone to come help her and nobody came. She tried to get out of bed alone and fell on the floor. My grandmother was left there for 13 hours before the family found her. They brought her home. She had had a mild heart attack from the experience. My mom moved in with her and tried to give her 24 hour care. This tragic experience dramatically affected me, compelling me to search for answers and alternatives to our current long term care and healthcare system.

One restless night in prayer, I felt led to get out of bed in the middle of the night. I prayed a little bit and thought "This is kind of silly." So I tried to go back to sleep, but felt a compelling need to wake up and turn on the television again. So I did. C-Span happened to be on. I heard a man talking about seniors, and the need for people to help service their growing population. It turned out to be Ken Deitchwold, an author for whose book I had been

aggressively looking to purchase for weeks, upon someone's strong recommendation. It was 4:00 in the morning.

While speaking on C-Span, Deitchwold looked at the camera and said the country is getting older, people are living longer and our government and health care system are not ready to take this on. Somebody has got to start a "Senior Corp." At that moment, I knew I was meant to answer that calling.

I had been at CBN for five years, and was then Senior Vice-President, managing much of the ministry. I shared my vision with Dr. Robertson and told him I felt a calling to leave CBN and start an organization that would "change the way America ages." After much prayer, I made the very risky leap of faith of leaving my job.

I went home and told my wife, who was pregnant with our second child, that we were doing this. We liquidated all the equity in our house. We cashed in our retirement accounts. We leveraged every credit card we had. We went from being financially solvent to being hundreds of thousands of dollars in debt. I went from a great salary to no salary. I bought a little healthcare company, which was God's way of having me learn the in-roads of the healthcare system. By my first day at the new job, I'd gone from a wonderful corner office at CBN to driving a wheelchair and diaper truck into some of the most dangerous neighborhoods in Virginia late at night. My faith had to be real!

The "desert experience" was a struggle. I went from no financial problems to starting my own business and having to hire a lot of employees. There were times when I did not know from where the money to make payroll would come. Many Fridays my wife and I spent on our knees, praying for miraculous deposits. We continued to tithe, even when there was nothing there. This constant financial struggle went on for a couple of years. But God is faithful! We always continued to make payroll. Miracles work in businesses, which is what businessmen need to know. Those darkest times in the desert are when God shines the most brilliantly!

Today, the vision given me is tangible in my company called Seniorcorp. We reproduce assisted living in peoples' homes, helping them to live healthier, longer and more independent lives at home. We give phenomenal, comprehensive care to people, and keep them out of the complicated medical maze. We provide affordable solutions from nurses, drivers, cooks, social workers, pharmacy and medication reviews, insurance management, hospital advocacy, and even home and doctor visits. 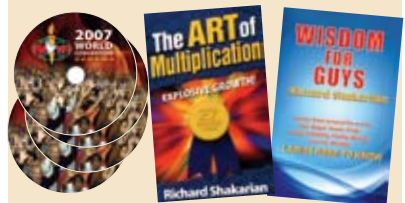

I COULD Do ANYTHING!

I was taught at a very young age that I could do anything I wanted to do, if I was willing to pay the price. I was determined that I was going to be a millionaire by the time I was 50, and really, I was a millionaire by the time I was 40. Anything I set my mind to, I went after with full guns ahead. I attribute this to the 3 P's of life: prayer, patience, and perseverance. But that is not enough if you don't know who your God is, because then you become the god in your life or money becomes your god. That's what happened to me. I had all these good intentions and I was helping all these people, but the sad part about it was that I became an arrogant, self-righteous, know-it-all who thought that I was the only one who had enough information to make intelligent decisions. I did not have an accountability partner like I have today. I was an independent person. Men are taught to be self-dependent, strong, and to stand on their own two feet. Men are not taught to share this with anybody else; but that's a lie. The word is not independent. There's not a person who can stand alone.

By the time I was 42, I was a self-made millionaire. I was very popular in town, in Leadership Macon, and on the St. Peter Claver Parish Council. It sounded like I was doing everything right. Then in February 1992, my wife hit me with a divorce after being married for 21 years. My father was dying of cancer and my seven million dollar development project was going under. So 1992 was my wake up year.


In fact, God knocked me out!

I look back on it now and realize that He had given me plenty of hints along the way, but I was taught that if you get knocked down, you get back up. I had gotten knocked down plenty of times, but I did what I was taught and kept getting back up and I would wear people down. I was taught some really good basic values about hard work and perseverance.

If you had asked me two weeks before my wife asked me for a divorce, I would have told you everything was okay. If you had asked my wife the very same question, she would have told you the marriage had been dead for ten years. I was so caught up in myself, in my empire, in my power building, and playing God, that I missed the most important lessons in life. I became very angry. I had a very large insurance policy and I was really worth more dead than alive. I was dying inside, so I told my 14-year-old daughter that I was going up to a cabin in the mountains and if I did not come back in two weeks, just send my friend up to come find me. What a terrible thing to tell my daughter! But by the grace of God, she wasn't paying much attention and just said, "Okay, Papa." Luckily, she didn't have a clue about what I was planning.

As I was leaving to take my life, a friend of mine came through the door and handed me a book. I was heading out to commit suicide! I was going to have it out with God. I was determined and hard-headed enough that if I didn't get any answers, I wasn't coming back. I didn't take anything with me: no food, water, or juice. But all of a sudden, this book was put in my hands. I threw it in the backseat of my car and didn't pay any attention to it. I was climbing around up in the mountains around Calloway Gardens, cussing at God. He wasn't saying anything.

I was getting bored and I picked up the book that was given to me that was called The Way of the Pilgrim. It was about a pilgrim who was making his way across Russia. He had read in the Bible that you were supposed to pray incessantly. He was traveling across Russia visiting all the monasteries asking how to pray incessantly. He came across a monk who told him to say the same prayer 3,000 times. Being an accountant, I was ready to tackle this. So I started praying,

“Lord Jesus Christ, have mercy on me, a sinner.”

The next night, I was yelling and screaming at God and He said nothing. I read a little more and the monk told the pilgrim to say the prayer 6,000 times. I did that and the next night, I read a little more and he said to say the prayer 12,000 times. I was not sleeping and my mouth was getting dry and swollen. This was happening to the pilgrim in the book as well. So the monk told him since he couldn't speak, to listen to his heartbeat and to say the prayer every time it beat. So I leaned up against a tree wrapped up in my army jacket in 20-degree weather and I tried to listen to my heartbeat. The last thing I remember was listening and saying that prayer until I passed out. The next morning there was a fine mist coming up over the valley. It was mystical and through the mist right next to me was a full-grown buck deer. If you know anything about bucks, they don't come up on humans in the woods. But he just looked at me, snorted one time and casually walked off just like I was nothing. I thought, “Wow, that was unbelievable, Lord!” I was talking to the Lord like He was a regular person! About that time, a white doe came bouncing along chasing after that buck. I exclaimed, “Lord, that is awesome! Where has this been, Lord?” And for the first time in my life God spoke to me. He said, “Here's the deal, Patrick, you think you're worth more dead than alive.” He then said, “If you can find one person, just one person who would take the money over your life, I'll let you commit suicide.”

Then He very lovingly and tenderly took me through the next four days. I thought of all of the people I could think of including my future ex-wife who at that point in time did not care for me too much. I knew in my heart of hearts that if she had a choice between the money and my life, she wouldn't take the money. The same would apply for the people who had invested money in my project and the same people who had loaned me money. Not a one of them would



take the money. And then when I got through all of the people I could think of, I said, “Lord, why?” He said, “Let me tell you why. They didn’t invest because they could make money from you. They invested in you because of your passion.” They invested in my passion and enthusiasm for things. They had invested in me. I couldn’t understand that because I had hurt everybody that I had tried to help. He convinced me that there must be something better.

So I came back from that mountain-time Job experience with a new understanding of who God was. He can take our hollering, screaming, and cussing. There is nothing you can say to God that will change His love for you. That was what He taught me that day.

What I learned from that experience in 1992 was how to hear God with my heart, instead of my mind. I prayed for the infilling of the Holy Spirit so I could discern what was in the Bible. Without any question He said, “You’ve got it.” You get alone with God and ask for it. The only way to overcome the sinful nature is to have the Holy Spirit in you. Receiving Christ as your Savior is just being saved. There are a lot of Christians that are saved and are going to heaven, but they don’t have any joy. They haven’t asked for the Baptism of the Holy Spirit which is the very means by which we fight our sinful nature.

Five years after my divorce, God put me in a Bible study being taught by a lady by the name of Velvet. The very first time we prayed, I held her hand and when she started praying, it felt as if my hand was on fire. I knew this woman would be my wife. It took me three months to get the nerve to ask her out. We had one date. We married three months later. I have two grown children. Velvet had problems with endometriosis all of her life and she loved my children so she decided to have a hysterectomy. It caused a hormone imbalance and she became a stranger to me and to herself for the next year. Many of my friends and family suggested that I should leave her. They kept asking me, “What are you waiting for?” But God told me to wait. God had not given me permission. God said, “Wait!”

So I waited. We finally went to this particular doctor who told her that the synapses in her brain were not working properly. He prescribed two medications and within two hours, she was back to herself again. She had been through a year of hell and I was thinking that I was lost again, and asking the Lord what was going on. He taught me a valuable lesson, TO WAIT ON THE LORD. God knows what He is doing.

I believe that our relationship with God is more like a grandfather and grandchild, rather than a father and child. I know that my experience as a father was full of mistakes. I didn't know what I was doing and I lived in so much fear that my children were going to turn out wrong because of my ignorance. In contrast, my relationship with my granddaughters and grandson is full of patience and wisdom. I just love them and enjoy them. I really believe that our relationship with God is more like a grandparent and grandchild because of that.

My testimony is very simple: Keep God first and love Him with your whole heart, mind, and soul; and then learn how to have a Godly love for your neighbor.

EMBEDDED...FOR HIS GLORY!

*At home, I was expected to contribute
to the chores of the family and to do
these things in a reliable manner.*

We were brought up not to complain but to press in and get the job done. We were taught to love and respect our elders and our country, to give a helping hand to those who needed it, and not to depend on others to carry us. We were taught to live by the Ten Commandments in a secular way but we were not raised in a house that worshiped the Lord or that acknowledged God.

Education was emphasized as the way out of poverty and the reward would be an easier life than our parents had during their growing up which was during the “Great Depression”. I maintained good enough grades and good SAT test scores to be accepted into VPI’s Engineering College in Blacksburg.

I started drinking beer every Friday and Saturday night on a steady basis at the age of 16, most every time driving home drunk. By the grace of God I never had a serious accident, hurt anyone else in a vehicle or was ticketed for drunken driving.

In college, my mind was even more distracted by partying and girls. During this time I was approached by my roommate and asked if I would like to participate in the purchase of an ounce of marijuana. I was thrilled to be included and willingly accepted the bait. That was the beginning of a 30 year habit of “pot addiction.”

I enlisted in the Air Force. Off I went to Lackland AFB, Texas, madly in love with a young woman I had met in a bar in Maryland. We were eventually married August 31, 1970. I was soon based in Columbus, Ohio at Lockbourne AFB.

Drinking was the center of my socializing and the central part of my entertainment. As a couple, we were young, immature and an extremely ill-prepared couple expecting our life to be like “Beaver Cleaver”. What a surprise we had coming.

I served my military time in the U.S., not assigned to Vietnam; a place I was terrified I would be sent. I believed if that was where I

was sent, I would be killed there. The spirit of fear was very much at work in me. In 1974 I was discharged from active duty.

I went back to my pre-service job of operating heavy machinery. I was again back to working hard, drinking hard, spending all that I earned and trying to provide for a wife and a son who was now two years old. Married life was always in limbo. I had no peace, always trying to please my immature wife, my immature self and trying to live a lie about what would bring joy into our lives and marriage.

I never did achieve any long-lasting wealth, or happiness, either for my wife or myself, and only fleeting respect. Alcohol, drugs, adultery and a home devoid of Jesus is a sure fire recipe for disaster.

Smoking pot began at age 19. I was separated from my wife at the age of 25, was committing adultery at 26 and gambling heavily at the age of 27. At the age of 32 a friend and I had gone to get something to drink at my store and he asked "do you want to try this" as he pulled out a bag of cocaine. I again said sure, loving the idea of being included in something that was forbidden.

In the next six months I was not only hooked on coke, I was buying an ounce of it every two weeks. At first I was fronting the cost and cutting it to sell and pay for my expanding habit which soon hit 3-4 grams a day. I would not sleep for three days or so at a time because of the speed effect it had. I was drinking a fifth of Jack Daniels a day to cool off the speed effects of the drug and chasing the proverbial "high" of euphoria--which never returns for the addict. I became so paranoid from the use of the drug that I carried a 357 magnum at all times.

Never was there any peace. Then during the mid 1980's came the Vietnam movies none of which were edifying to the men and women who served in Vietnam. With these movies came guilt for me, a form of "survivor guilt," for I had not gone to Vietnam and had even maneuvered my way around serving over there during the war.

Drink, dance, party and commit fornication: it was my way of life. Still things looked to be improving in my life. I was building paper wealth, my business was booming and I was buying a couple of good pieces of property. I was the picture of prosperity. The woman I had started to live with and eventually I got married in 1988 after

my divorce from my first wife. Then things again started to change with all kinds of arguments inflamed by alcohol, jealousy, suspicion, immaturity and insecurity.

I was told it was my drinking that caused all of our problems in my second marriage, as well. I had come to a point that something had to change, for my life was filled with pain. My wife was gone and she was always looking to replace me. My business started to fail and my children were fed up with me, my broken promises, and lies. It was all coming to an abrupt end.

In addition to the medical prescriptions, I decided to turn to the Bible. I began reading an old King James version, starting in Genesis. This was mighty hard reading, but I praise the SPIRIT that had started to draw me. My wife and I reunited and for a short time there was

peace. Then she went right back to her friends. I moved out and decided that I would now start reading the Bible and that I would have that peace in my life that I had never known.

From that day, Jesus' hand was on me. I went to church the next day. It was the first time I had ever gone looking for this thing called God. He met me there that day at the United Methodist Church of Stumptown. The pastor said something that hit me between the spiritual eyes. She said, "If you do not know Jesus as your Lord and Savior, you will not go to Heaven, you will go to hell!" I did not say anything at that point for I thought that all you needed to do was be able to spell the word God and you would be saved. The one thing I did was go home and start reading to check that out. Praise God again for He is faithful. He gave me a hungering and thirsting for His Word. All I did was read the Bible when I had spare time. God kept bringing people into my life and giving me the place in scripture that not only gave me answers, but answered questions I did not know enough to ask.

On December 17, 1999 in a time of despair and distress which lasted for a couple of weeks, even contemplating suicide, the Lord Jesus Christ came into my life that night as I sat there on that wood floor and gave my life to Him. I did not know what had happened to me. I had a joy in my heart from that point on until this day, which has only grown deeper.

I had been blessed with a child-like faith. I believed God's Word. Whatever it said is what I believed and still believe. God gave me the gift to put myself in every situation in the Bible as He would see appropriate for my situation, to teach me. This is the God, the Lord Jesus, who saved my life and gave me a purpose to live. I had failed at everything I thought would bring me success and joy. Now I had all I needed to live a life of peace and eternal life with Jesus.

One week after being saved I was on the way to work, praising His name when I was filled with the Holy Spirit as He came into my life with His power. One year later almost to the week I hosted a radio program named "Take A Stand" which the Lord gave me to minister on a small radio station and to train me for what He would bring next in short order. Though there have been challenges there has always been the knowledge since I came to Jesus that whatever the trial--if I kept my eyes on Jesus, I would come through it in victory.

I want to give all praise to Jesus for completely delivering me from the bondages of alcohol, drugs, gambling, adultery, anger and rage, and the spirit of rejection; the place of low self-esteem, because my life had come to failure. My second marriage was falling apart, my two sons could not tolerate me, and my business was failing. There was no place to go and at my lowest point when I was contemplating suicide, the Lord reached out to me and beckoned me.

I need to stress that I am NOT a recovering alcoholic, drug addict, gambler or adulterer, I am totally set free of all these things through the power of the Lord Jesus and the Word. I am a new creation in Jesus Christ.

I was embedded with the 91st Engineers attached to the 2nd BCT, 1st Cavalry Division, Baghdad. During the course of my 5 embedded trips to Iraq spending a total of 6 months living among our troops in Iraq and Afghanistan, I observed the accomplishments of our troops

and the misrepresentation of the main stream media along with the affect this had upon our troops and their families. There were many opportunities to pray for our men and their situations not only there in Iraq, but for their family situations back home.

I know that the Lord had sent me there to observe, come back to the U.S. and to report the truth and the truth of God's protection as I saw IED's explode, RPG's fired, mortar rounds blowing up next to us and several attacks of small arms against us. Each time I gave God the praise for His protection in front of the troops who I was with.

During the course of my time back in the U.S., I have been the guest speaker on over 450 radio programs addressing our situation in Iraq, and the peril of the present day radical Islam to Israel and America. My new radio ministry will focus on the military veteran, the soldier and their families who have been so ravaged by the demonic forces of the devil.
